

Supplies: Scissors Pencil with eraser or straw

Straight pin or tack Colored pencils, markers or crayons to decorate your pinwheel

How to get started:

Cut out the pinwheel at the top of this page. Color or decorate with colored pencils, markers or crayons. Following the lines on the template, cut in from all four corners, leaving about 2 inches of the center uncut. Gently bend (do not fold) on of the corners with a gray circle to the center point. Skip the next corner and bend the next one. Repeat until all four points meet in the center. Stick the straight pin through all four points and back of the pinwheel. Stick the pin into either the pencil eraser or the straw. Find wind and test your pinwheel!
